## **OCTCR33I553112 - Connector is Unable to Receive Any Events After Installation**

**Issue:** The connector is unable to receive any event after installation, if you have installed the latest version of ATAP Plus connector on a machine where MISP Model Import Connector was previously installed.

**Workaround:** Clear cache from the user/agent/agentdata folder, then restart the connector. The connector will now be able to receive events and send events to destination.
