ArcSight Logger is a storage solution optimized for extremely high event throughput. An event is a time-stamped log entry, either sent by protocols such as syslog, or appended to a log file. Logger receives and stores events, and can optionally forward selected events.

Logger CIP for PCI is a package of alerts, reports, saved searches and dashboards that leverage the latest features of ArcSight Logger like the smart reporting engine, that can assist you in complying with the PCI requirements specified in the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard 3.2.1.

SOL-6002	On rare cases the alert "PCI Requirement 6 - Insecure Communications Detected" could generate false positive results if a vulnerability found on zone name contains the word communication like "Level 3 communication Inc 2".
