Connected MX ExportData Tool 4.11.0

Enhancements

This section describes the enhancements in this release. For more information about a specific one, see the ExportData Tool Help Center or contact Micro Focus Support.

Support for folder export option. Internal enhancements to the tool support the new export task where you can specify folder paths present on the devices. (TT-20947)

With this enhancement:

- The **Request Name** can now be up to 64 characters in length.
 - There are two new filter options, **Basic** and **RegEx**.
 - In the **Basic** option, you can specify multiple folder paths by giving either the complete full text path or with wild card characters and maximum of 20 folder paths can be mentioned. The **Folder path** option can be specified along with **File name** and **File extension** options to narrow down the exported data from the devices.
 - In the **RegEx** option, you must provide both the folder path and its name along with file type or extension in the regular expression.
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Limitations

Issue: On macOS, while using Command Line Interface (CLI), back slashes (\) are automatically

ignored or escaped. (TT-34999)

NOTE: It is recommended to use only the forward slash (/) to separate the folders in the hierarchy.

Issue: When running on a Mac platform, after data export is successful, unable to open the folder from ExportData tool when the data export request name contains special characters. (TT-34334)

Issue: Due to data protection measures introduced in macOS 10.15 (Catalina), if you attempt to download or install the ExportData tool to a folder that contains either your documents or other personal files in your user profile, macOS prompts whether to allow access.

Additional prompts occur whenever the tool attempts to export files to one of the protected folders for the first time. For the tool to export the files, you must allow access. After granting access to a specific folder, you are not prompted again for that location unless you manually revoke access through the macOS Security & Privacy settings.

Issue: In CMX-KMS environments, you cannot export data for users that are on-hold. (TT-30248)
