Version 24.1

1 - Platform and System Requirements

1.1 - .NET

All components using .NET target .NET 7 runtime. Depending on the component, it may require either the .NET Desktop or ASP.NET Core runtime.

Each File Dynamics package installer will install any necessary .NET system runtime. In cases where Internet access is not available, you must install the required .NET runtime as indicated below.

1.3 - Supported Databases

1.3.1 - SQL Server

This release of File Dynamics requires an instance of Microsoft SQL Server. The following editions of SQL Server are supported with this release.

- SQL Server 2022
- SQL Server 2019

Supported SQL Server Editions

- SQL Server Enterprise
- SQL Server Standard
- SQL Server Express

1.3.2 - CouchDB

File Dynamics 24.1 has been tested with the latest releases of CouchDB 3.3.x and 3.2.x.



NOTE: While previous versions may continue to work, we strongly recommend upgrading to a current supported version found on the CouchDB download site <https://couchdb.apache.org/#download>.

2 - Required Product Updates

2.1 - Product Upgrades

File Dynamics 24.1 only supports direct upgrades from version 6.5 or later. If you are running a version of File Dynamics earlier than 6.5, please upgrade to that version first before attempting to upgrade to version 24.1.

2.2 - Required Component Updates

File Dynamics 24.1 requires all components to be upgraded to version 24.1 or later. Previous versions of the Event Monitor and Agent services, Data Owner Client, and Admin Client cannot communicate with the File Dynamics 24.1 Engine.

3 - New Features and Updates

3.1 - File Dynamics 24.1

3.1.1 - Product Version

Starting with this release product versions are now date based using *Year.Quarter* representation. The 24.1 release is based on a date of first quarter 2024.

Note that an internal version is still maintained separately but is not the version primarily surfaced in user interfaces.

3.1.2 - Cross-Empire Data Migration (CEDM)

CEDM is now available as a separate download. For customers who are licensed for the CEDM feature, a separate license file and install package is available.

Users of the standard edition of File Dynamics are eligible to receive CEDM licensing. (File Dynamics Essentials is not eligible.)

3.1.3 - Third-Party Components

All third-party components have been updated to recent versions, providing recent vendor updates and security fixes.

3.2 - File Dynamics 6.6

3.2.1 - Rebranded for OpenText

This release includes rebranding for OpenText. This update affects not only user interfaces, but also installation, data paths and default values.

Note that the installers and configuration tools provide a transparent migration to the new paths with little or no need for user interaction.

3.2.2 - OpenSSL 3.0

All components making use of OpenSSL now use version 3.0 of this library.

3.2.3 - .NET 7.0

This release brings all .NET applications to version 7.0. Depending on the application, the .NET Desktop Runtime 7.0 or ASP.NET Core Runtime 7.0 is installed as a system package or self-contained with the application itself.

3.2.4 - Data Owner Web Service

An initial release of the Data Owner web service is included with this release. Users who prefer the simplicity of accessing a web service over the installation and deployment of a desktop client may now use this service.

3 - New Features and Updates

As this is an initial release, not all features found in the desktop client are currently available.

3.2.5 - Security Updates

This release addresses multiple security updates including OpenSSL 3.0 and removal of outdated protocols.

3.3 - File Dynamics 6.5

3.3.1 - Security Notification Policies

Technology previously offered in Security Notify policies has been updated and enhanced to maintain historical information – not just one previous scan.

3.3.2 - Security Lockdown Policies

These new Target-Driven policies let you establish the baseline permissions for designated high-value targets. When unauthorized access permissions are made, the new permissions are removed and the baseline permissions are restored.

3.3.3 - Security Fencing Policies

These new Target-Driven policies let you set limits on how access permissions can change over time by specifying containers, groups, or users that can be given access permissions and others that should never be given access permissions.

Epoch Data Protection has been discontinued and is no longer included as of this release.
