Improved support for multiple email addresses in Request file

Request file feature now supports multiple comma-separated email addresses. This enhancement allows you to send file requests to several recipients at once, improving efficiency and collaboration. Increased character limit for note fields in Share and Request file dialogs

Notes filed in **Share and Request file** dialogs in **Web Client** now allows you to enter up to 2048 characters. This enhancement gives you more space to include detailed messages or instructions when sharing or requesting files.

Improved phone number validation in self-registration

Self-registration form now validates phone numbers to prevent users from entering a leading zero after the country code. This enhancement ensures that only valid phone numbers are accepted, improving the reliability of SMS delivery.

Fixed Issues

- SQL errors occurred in appserver.log during **Folder and Net Folder** deletion operations.
- Windows 11 Explorer crashes if the **Preview pane** is enabled in Filr 24.1.1.
- Filr Web UI allows external users to change their email address.
- Multiple email addresses can be imported into the **Request file** dialog box using comma-separated values.

- **Notes field** character limit increased to 2048 for **Share and Request file** dialog box in the Web Client.
- Filr self-registration for external users does not validate the mobile number prefix.

Known Issues

Error in Desktop client after previewing PowerPoint files with Outlook plugin

On Windows 11, when the Outlook plugin is installed, an unexpected error message appears in the desktop client after previewing a PowerPoint file (PPT/PPTX) using the Windows Preview pane and then attempting to open a different file.

Filr Admin Console fails to load after patching to 25.1.2

After applying the Filr 25.1.2 patch, the Filr Admin Console (port 8443) may fail to load and return an HTTP 500 error when Filr is connected to an MS SQL database. This issue occurs because the `sqlserver-changelog-master.xml` file contains an incorrect path, which prevents the database update from completing successfully.
