## New in this Release

The following new features were released in Azure Blob Connector version 12.5.0.

- The connector supports the `identifiers` fetch action. In NiFi Ingest, when you configure the `GetAzureBlob` processor, you can choose the items to synchronize through a graphical interface on the advanced configuration page. There is also a `ListAzureBlob` processor to support the `identifiers` action in NiFi.
- The connector can obtain details about your HTTP proxy from the system. Instead of setting `ProxyHost`, `ProxyPort`, `ProxyUsername`, and `ProxyPassword`, you can set the new configuration parameter `UseSystemProxy` to `TRUE`.
