New in this Release

The following new features were released in Find version 12.8.0.

- Security improvements have been made to prevent clickjacking.
- When listing ControlPoint policies, Find now shows only the policies that the user has permissions for.
- Find now has a Related Users tab, which shows other users that are interested in topics related to the current search, and users designated as experts on topics related to the current search.

To enable the tab, you must add `related-users` to the list in the configuration file, and set `users.relatedUsers.enabled` to **true**. For more information, refer to the *Find Administration Guide*.

- On the settings page, there is now an option to enable explicit profiling as part of the QMS configuration. This setting is enabled by default.

Resolved Issues

The following issues were resolved in Find version 12.8.0.

- Changes to ControlPoint configuration did not take effect until Find was restarted.
- Users with the FindBI role could access a lot of information about other users, such as email address, last-logged-in time, and a full field listing. Now, only the username is accessible, unless you enable the related users feature, in which case userID, email address, and the fields you configure to display are also accessible.
