

NetIQ PlateSpin Recon 4 NetIQ End User License Agreement

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"Physical Server" means a physical computer system, whether in a network that is shared by multiple users or on its own, that may contain one or more CPUs, cores, or processors. For purposes of this definition, A Physical Server is limited to running a single operating system for Windows, Linux, Solaris, AIX UNIX or NetWare on the hardware, which cannot be a virtual infrastructure, or hypervisor and which cannot host Virtual Machines.

"Server" means each Physical Server, Virtual Host Server, and Virtual Machine.

"Software License Key" means the mechanism that enables You to install and use the Software subject to the restrictions set out in this Agreement and may be a printable digital key, a non-printable file or any other mechanism used by Licensor for license activation purposes.

"Virtual Host Server" means a physical computer system, whether in a network that is shared by multiple users or on its own, that may contain one or more CPUs, cores, or processors, and which hosts a virtual infrastructure, hypervisor or Virtual Machines.

"Virtual Machines" or "VM" means a software container that can run its own operating system and execute applications like a physical server.

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
