New product offering addresses dynamic demands for today's organizations.

For more than a decade, Storage Manager has evolved as a single product in support of customers in both eDirectory and Active Directory environments. Although a single product offering, Storage Manager has consisted of two deliverables, one for each environment. However, the need to develop and release new versions and updates to both sets of customers on their own cadence became more and more evident over time.

To better support customers, OpenText introduced File Dynamics as the evolution of Storage Manager for Active Directory in June of 2018. File Dynamics focuses solely on the dynamic demands of today's Active Directory organizations when it comes to data governance, growth, automation, compliance, security, and protection.

OpenText remains committed to Storage Manager eDirectory customers and will continue to evolve and support the product indefinitely. Look for an update soon for that product.

File Dynamics provides all of the identity-driven file system management capabilities of Storage Manager for Active Directory, along with a considerable amount of new features enabled through new target-driven policies:

- Copy, move, and groom files located on any location on the network

- Protect files from data loss or corruption such as a ransomware attack
- Handle work processes initiated from other applications
- Notify selected individuals when access permissions to high-value targets change
- Monitor and lock down changes in access permissions to high-value targets
- Set limits on how access permissions evolve through group inclusion and exclusion lists
- Assign data owners to be notified of access permission changes, perform data recovery, or perform remediation tasks

Upgrading from Storage Manager for Active Directory to File Dynamics

Much like upgrading from one version of Storage Manager to another, the process of upgrading from Storage Manager to File Dynamics is seamless. Existing policy definitions will move to the new product, and Storage Manager customers will be right at home in the File Dynamics UI.

File Dynamics, with its extensive product capabilities, has a higher per-user license price than Storage Manager for Active Directory. Upgrade
