What are Business Process Models in SAP

Enterprises with SAP define and control the 'way they work' through its business processes covering everything from onboarding employees, order fulfillment, and shipping; it's how the business organizes itself, its personnel, and its software to support those tasks. Business Process Management is how you capture,

control and improve activity flows and the Business Processes Model Notation (BPMN) is the graphical representation that documents the process.

More recently, with the growth of Business Process Mining solutions, such as SAP Signavio or Celonis, enterprises are automatically discovering what process are really being followed, with what frequency and producing Business Process Models to show that. SAP even publishes BPMN files which correspond to their Best Practice, as part of the SAP Activate deployment methodology for customers to use.

MBT Impact on SAP Testing

These Business Process Models accurately and comprehensively define what activity streams the business needs to complete and hence what functionality the supporting SAP software needs to have. As an SAP tester, you need to ensure that when the system is deployed users will be able to complete all the expected process from start to finish. With MBT, you simply import the pre-defined models, use a coverage strategy to automatically divide it into Paths and then automatically create associated Model Based Test containers.

These can be run manually right away, or form the basis for creating intelligent based automated tests using either the embedded AI Codeless tool or with the industry leading UFT One Functional Testing solution. Parameterization and Data Sets


Inbuilt into MBT is the ability to store and connect multiple data sets connected to script-based input or output parameters, in this way you can pass information between units of a scripts enhancing and increasing flexibility of what you are automating. MBT has the ability hold multiple data sets which can be copied or imported from an external file so you can be sure you will always have the right data for the execution you are performing.



Using MBT prebuilt Model to path to test conversion strategies you can easily select the coverage you want to achieve for your created paths and then tests. MBT will do all the work for you, converting a single model into multiple paths against establishing the coverage you required. You then tell MBT what to convert to tests and it will create and associate those tests. Of course, you still have the option to create process paths manually if you want.

Native Creation and Update of Business Process Diagrams

If you don't have your Business Process Models defined or captured already OpenText MBT lets you create your own Business Flows directly inside of the tool. You can then use the models to define Test Paths and Data but with the advantage of doing so from the business perspective.
